During its 13-year history, the band has performed The Beatles' "Sgt. Peppers Lonely Hearts Club Band" and "White Album" in their entirety, served as the sole live orchestration for theatrical productions of "The Who's Tommy" and "Jesus Christ Superstar," and showcased evenings devoted entirely to the music of George Harrison, Steely Dan and the Allman Brothers.

So accurate are the band's performances that *The Idea Festival*, a four-day conference of "extraordinary thinkers," selected them to play at the reception for Sir George Martin following his presentation of "The Making of the Greatest Album of All Time: Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band." Now, that's an endorsement!

In addition, the band has produced a CD of original material called "Tastes Like Chicken," a powerful combination of funk, rock, jazz, blues and Latin influences.
